Subject: Complaint against Shri Shubham Agarwal regarding submission of false and forged disability certificate-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that this Department has received multiple complaints/representations from Shri Ashish Gupta alleging that Shri Shubham Agarwal furnished false and forged disability certificates for claiming reservation benefits under the Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) category.

2. In this regard, it is stated that while complaining about Shri Shubham Agarwal in connection with his candidature in Civil Services Examination (CSE), 2024, the complainant has also alleged that the documents used for employment in the Board of Revenue, Uttar Pradesh Government are forged.

3. In this connection, it is also pertinent to inform that Shri Shubham Agarwal has been found ineligible under the Hearing Impairment sub-category of Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) category in the medical examination done by the empaneled Hospital as his disability has been assessed to be below the benchmark. Therefore, his candidature for CSE - 2024 has already been cancelled for being an invalid PwBD candidate.

4. Further, Shri Shubham had also applied for the Civil Services Examination (CSE) in previous years under the Hearing Impairment (HI) disability category. Accordingly, this Department undertook his disability assessments during the CSE - 2017, 2018, 2020, and 2022. The assessments in those years also determined his disability percentages indicating that he did not qualify as a valid Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) candidate.


5. Since it is alleged that the same disability certificates have also been submitted before authorities under the Government of Uttar Pradesh, the matter is being forwarded for strict necessary action, as may be considered appropriate, by

the State Government. The Copies of the complaints/representations received in this Department are enclosed for reference and necessary action.

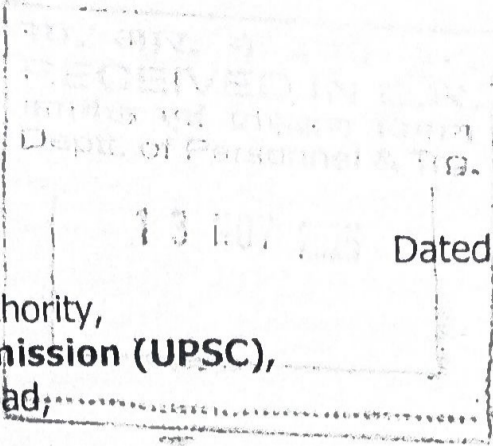

Subject: Complaint regarding submission of false and forged medical disability certificate by Mr. Shubham Agarwal S/o Shri Ashwani Agarwal, cleared under PwBD Category in UPSC Examination, 2024.

Ref: Writ Petition (C) No. 12030 of 2025 and Writ Petition (C) No. 13162 of 2025 both titled "Shubham Agarwal Versus Union of India & Anr." before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi

Respected Sir,

1. That I, Ashish Gupta, respectfully submit this complaint seeking appropriate legal and departmental actions against Mr. Shubham Agarwal, who was selected in the Civil Services Examination, 2024 under the Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) category by submitting false, fabricated, and manipulated medical certificates. Shubham Agarwal is currently posted as Nayab Tehsildar from 1-10-2021, employed by Board of Revenue U.P., selected on the basis of 'Physical Disability' by Public Service Commission, U.P. Prayagraj under Upper Subordinate Service Exam, 2019.

2. That Mr. Shubham Agarwal claimed himself to be 40% permanently disabled, on the strength of a disability certificate purportedly issued by the Chief Medical Officer (CMO), Ghaziabad; and declared 44% permanently disabled by VMMC & Safdarjung Hospital, Delhi. However, when the UPSC conducted his medical examination during the recruitment process, he was found to be 0% and 1% disabled in medical examination(s) repeatedly according to findings of Benchmark Disability Expert Panel (BDEP) held at AIIMS, Delhi which clearly indicates that the certificate initially submitted was false and forged, at least, the findings do not corroborate with the certificates he submitted himself to UPSC/UPPCS. I request the competent authority to verify the medical documents submitted in UPPCS and UPSC as admittedly the said documents are self contradictory.

3. That thereafter, a Medical Board was constituted and his medical examination was conducted at the Army Hospital (R & R), Delhi, which

surprisingly certified his disability as 67.84% (evidently all his disability certificates which were submitted by him mentions his condition as non-progressive/ not likely to improve), a finding that is drastically inconsistent with the earlier results of 0%, 1% and 40–44% disability. This huge variation strongly indicates manipulation and misuse of official channels to trying to obtain government appointment under the PwBD category.

4. That the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its Order dated 06.10.2025 in W.P. (C) No. 13162 of 2025, has taken cognizance of these inconsistencies and directed that a fresh medical examination of Mr. Shubham Agarwal be conducted by a Medical Board consisting of three doctors from three different organisations, noting the serious difference between the previous assessments of 1% and 67.84% disability. One member of the Board would be nominated by the Director of AIIMS, one by the Director General of the CGHS, and the third by Chief of the Army Research and Referral Hospital, New Delhi.
5. That I am the real brother-in-law of Mr. Shubham Agarwal, being married to his real sister Mrs. Anchal Agarwal. Instant Complaint is being filed to bring this to the notice of competent authorities, and not for my personal interest, infact to pointing out the pattern of misconduct as well as to ensure the transparency to maintain the integrity of public recruitment in esteemed national importnace institutions such as UPPCS and UPSC.
 - a. Mr. Shubham's real brother, Mr. Arpit Agarwal, has lodged a false and malicious criminal case against me and five members of my family under Sections 498A, 323, 324, 504, 506, 307 of IPC and Sections 3 & 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, at PS Madhuban Bapudham by submitting false medical documents issued from MMG Hospital, Ghaziabad. The said FIR No. 346/2022 was registered four days after the alleged occurrence allegedly happenned in Jyoti Nagar, Delhi, almost more than 17 KMs away from the place of Hospital in Ghaziabad (falling under the control of CMO, Ghaziabad) wherefrom Two Medical Certificates which are incomplete and appear to be forged are enclosed in the said FIR/Complaint. It is pertinent to mention here that possession of these incomplete medical documents prior to signing and filling relevant details with the brother of Shubham Agarwal shows that Arpit Agarwal has hand in glove with the doctors of Ghaziabad and they can manange to obtain medical documents of their choice.

6. That during the investigation of the said criminal case, the medical documents collected by the police were found to be materially different from the ones annexed with the complaint. This clearly demonstrates that Mr. Shubham Agarwal and his family have access to and have previously used fabricated medical documents, thereby reinforcing the suspicion that even the disability certificates submitted to UPSC and UPPCS are forged and false.

7. That the above criminal case is presently pending trial bearing S.T. No. 679/2023 before the Court of the Additional Sessions Judge-9, Ghaziabad, where the prosecution evidence is in progress. During the cross-examination of Mr. Arpit Agarwal (real brother of Shubham Agarwal), he has categorically **admitted on oath that there is no disabled person in his family**. He has cross-examined at length pertaining to the medical documents annexed with the said false Complaint against me and my family. This admission i.e. there is no disabled person in the family corroborates the fact that Shubham Agarwal has falsely projected himself as a disabled person to obtain undue benefit in UPSC and other public recruitments.

8. That I came to know about the manipulation of medical certificates and the Hon'ble High Court's direction for re-examination of Shubham Agarwal reports published in the reputed legal news platforms such as "Live Law", Indian Kanoon, Case Mine, Raw Law etc. The said articles brought to public notice that the Hon'ble Court had observed wide discrepancies in the medical assessment of Mr. Shubham Agarwal's disability status and therefore directed for his third medical examination.

9. That the family of Mr. Shubham Agarwal is engaged in business under the name and style of "Ashwani & Sons", having a factory situated at 1246/2, Meerut Road, falling under P.S. Madhuban Bapudham, Ghaziabad and one more large industry establishment in the name of "Ashish Industries" situated at 1337, Mainapur Road, within P.S. Madhuban Bapudham, Ghaziabad, as listed vendors linking them to Military Engineering Services and Army establishments.

a. In view of their business relations and local influence, there is a strong possibility that the 67.84% disability certificate issued by the Army Hospital was obtained through misuse of Shubham's family contacts and influence. It is also pertinent to mention that in the aforesaid false criminal case, they have shown their factory address

as residential address, thereby misrepresenting facts to the police authorities.

- b. This pattern of using different addresses to evade scrutiny is evident in the candidate DAF where he has been using different addresses as per convenience so that earlier medical records related to his candidature can't be accessed easily.

10. That in view of the above facts and circumstances, there are glaring discrepancies and stark contradictions indicating that Mr. Shubham Agarwal has manipulated his disability status, submitted false medical certificates, and misused official procedures in order to secure selection under the PwBD category, thereby deceiving the Commission and the Government of India.

11. It is relevant to submit that in recent times, multiple instances of irregularities in disability claims in public recruitment processes have come to national attention. The Government of India and UPSC as a custodian of highest merit standards have, in those cases, acted swiftly and decisively to protect integrity and transparency. Hence, strict scrutiny in the present matter is consistent with current institutional policy standards, where UPSC in one of the cases has also cancelled the provisional candidature of the applicant and permanently debarred from any future UPSC examinations.

I therefore humbly request you to:

(i) Conduct a comprehensive inquiry into the disability certificates submitted by Mr. Shubham Agarwal; with UPPCS, Prayagraj and UPSC, New Delhi

(ii) Verify the authenticity and source of the certificates issued to Shubham Agarwal;

(iii) Take appropriate disciplinary, vigilance and legal action as per rules against Mr. Shubham Agarwal if the forgery and misrepresentation are established; and

(iv) Inform the Hon'ble High Court, Central Administrative Tribunal and the concerned Medical Authorities about the findings of UPSC in this regard.

(v) Kindly recommend registration of FIR for offences made against the wrongdoers

That I am ready and willing to provide all relevant documents, including certified copies of the Complaint alongwith the Medical Documents, Statement of real brother of Shubham Agarwal alongwith his cross-examination, the said FIR, Live Law articles, and relevant medical certificates, as available on the judicial file of Ghaziabad Court, in support of the above facts whenever required by the Commission or investigating authorities.

This complaint is made by me in public interest. Not seeking any personal relief, I bring the matter to your notice so that the State may protect the purity and integrity of public recruitment, especially of highest standards in esteemed national organizations.

I request that this matter be treated with urgency, as it involves serious misuse of the PwBD quota and false representation before a constitutional recruiting body, thereby undermining the integrity of the Civil Services Examination process.

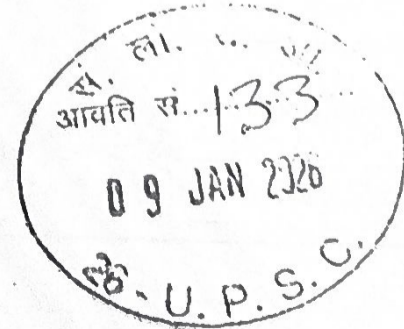

Subject: Request for expeditious action on Complaint No. DOPAT/E/2025/0011261 and information regarding action taken after final decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Union of India and UPSC versus Shubham Agarwal dated 22.05.2026

I respectfully submit this representation seeking your kind and immediate intervention in a matter concerning protection of reservation benefits meant for genuine Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) and action on Complaints submitted by me, in DoPT, UPSC and CVC, etc.

The complaint pertains to misuse of disability-reservation claim of Shubham Agarwal in connection with Civil Services Examination, 2024. My complaint was supported by extensive documentary records, medical assessments, judicial proceedings and other relevant material which were brought to the notice of the concerned authorities.

The Department of Personnel & Training subsequently acknowledged that the complaint had been taken on record. During RTI proceedings, it was informed that final action on the complaint would be considered after conclusion of the pending litigation.

The judicial proceedings have now attained finality before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No. 8074/2026 arising out of SLP(C) No. 13947/2026 (Union of India & UPSC vs. Shubham Agarwal), disposed of on 22.05.2026. The Hon'ble Supreme Court constituted an independent expert Medical Board at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai and ultimately discharged UPSC and Union of India from considering the candidature of Shri Shubham Agarwal under the PwBD category in Civil Services Examination, 2024, and also noted about the evasive conduct of Shubham Agarwal, who escaped the medical tests.

It is respectfully submitted that the final judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court substantially reinforces the concerns raised in my original complaint. The complaint had sought examination of the false and fraudulent disability basis on which reservation benefits were claimed and highlighted serious inconsistencies in the medical assessments forming the foundation of such claims.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court further recorded the non-completion of the Court-directed medical evaluation despite numerous opportunities granted and ultimately discharged UPSC and the Union of India from considering the candidature under the PwBD category in Civil Services Examination, 2024. While the Court did not adjudicate upon allegations of fraud or forgery, the final outcome of the proceedings

demonstrates that the concerns raised in my complaint were neither frivolous nor unfounded and were serious enough to require examination by the Central Administrative Tribunal, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, and ultimately the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The final outcome validates the concerns in my complaint and now requires examination from your department for possible criminal action and thus it is necessary to initiate legal, departmental and punitive proceedings against Shubham Agarwal.

It is respectfully submitted that the Hon'ble Supreme Court considered the matter serious enough to direct constitution of an independent expert Medical Board at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai. Such an extraordinary course is rarely adopted and demonstrates that the concerns raised regarding the disability claim required scrutiny beyond the ordinary administrative process. The final outcome therefore lends substantial weight to the concerns raised in my complaint and warrants a thorough examination by the competent authorities.

In view of the final judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the conclusion of all pending judicial proceedings, it is respectfully submitted that the issues raised in my complaint now require a final determination by the competent authorities. If, upon examination of the records, disability certifications, medical assessments, recruitment documents, and findings emerging from the judicial proceedings, it is found that any disability benefit, reservation benefit, appointment, candidature, certificate, declaration, or public employment was obtained through misrepresentation, suppression of material facts, false information, fabricated records, or any other unlawful means, appropriate criminal proceedings including registration of FIR, departmental action, vigilance action, and all other consequential proceedings permissible under law may kindly be initiated against all persons found responsible.

This same person Mr. Shubham Agarwal is also employed by Government of Uttar Pradesh as Nayab Tehsildar in Physical Disability category since 2021(eHRMS – 1683318). So the current status of his disability status as decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court may kindly be informed to concerned state authorities and necessary verification at highest levels of state and termination of service be advised at the state level as well.

I therefore most respectfully request that:

1. The present status and action taken on my Complaints may kindly be informed to me.
2. The concerned officers may be directed to examine and finalize the complaint expeditiously in light of the final judicial outcome.
3. If examination of the complaint and connected records reveals any irregularity, suppression, misrepresentation, wrongful procurement of reservation benefits, or other violation of law, appropriate legal, vigilance, departmental and criminal action may kindly be undertaken on priority in accordance with law.

4. The current status of his disability status be informed to concerned state authorities in the U.P. and necessary verification at the highest levels of state be advised so that any wrongdoing can be unearthed at the state level as well.
5. A speaking order indicating the final decision taken on Complaint No. DOPAT/E/2025/0011261 may kindly be communicated to me.

The matter concerns not only an individual candidature but also the larger issue of safeguarding opportunities reserved for genuine Persons with Disabilities. I therefore request your kind intervention for an expeditious and fair resolution of the complaint.

I shall remain grateful for your consideration.
